This Week's Focus

Reading-

- In reading this week we reviewed fiction concepts using Flocabulary songs, and practiced using those skills with an online quiz website called "Quizizz."
- We reviewed characters and character traits, setting, and themes.

Writing-

- In writing we continued working on our poetry project.
