This Week's Focus

Reading-

- In reading this week we reviewed how to make inferences while reading fiction, as well as how to find the main idea in a nonfiction text.
- We also reviewed text structure and practiced finding causes and effects, and problems and solutions in nonfiction passages.

Writing-
